The Agreement came into force on 4 Sep 2006 and the ReCAAP-ISC was officially launched on 29 Nov 2006.

- 1st multilateral government-to-government anti-piracy effort in the region.
- ReCAAP ISC to be setup in Singapore as an International Organisation (IO) with local & foreign staff.

"To be the information hub for combating piracy and armed robbery against ships in Asia."




# Integrated effort by agencies




"All for ONE and ONE for all" .... Shared responsibility.
